



## BEST PRACTICES

### Teaching–Learning Methods

- ❖ The institution adopts a wide range of effective and innovative teaching–learning methods to enhance student understanding and clinical competence.
- ❖ All classrooms are well equipped with the required teaching aids, and the laboratories are adequately furnished with modern equipment to support hands-on learning.
- ❖ Nursing procedures such as **heart sound auscultation, lung sound auscultation, Ryle's tube insertion, IV cannulation, IV Infusion, Catheterization, endotracheal intubation, Basic Life Support (BLS), Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS), Skill cubes demonstrating cardiac algorithms etc** are taught using **highly advanced digital simulators** in the **Nursing Foundations and Advanced Skill Laboratories**. Lectures and skill demonstrations are conducted by subject experts.
- ❖ In clinical areas, teaching–learning activities include **nursing rounds, bedside clinics, and patient case-based scenarios**, which help students develop clinical reasoning and decision-making skills.
- ❖ For the assessment of practical skills, the institution has planned to appoint **external examiners** for conducting **term-end practical examinations** from the current academic year onwards, ensuring transparency and quality evaluation.

### Learning Resources

- ❖ Students have access to a well-equipped physical library with a wide range of textbooks, reference books, and journals. Additionally, students can access the **e-library through the institutional website**.
- ❖ They also have access to **MUHS Digital Library, EBSCO, Knimbus MUHS, and MUHS thesis repository** through the website. Online academic resources such as **Semantic Scholar, PubMed, and Open Educational Resources (OER)** are also available to students directly via the college website, promoting self-directed and research-oriented learning.

### Student Support

- ❖ The institution provides **guidance and counseling services** to support students' academic, personal, and professional development. Mentorship records are maintained systematically by faculty members.
- ❖ **Suggestion boxes and complaint boxes** are placed in accessible locations within the college premises to encourage students to share feedback and suggestions.
- ❖ A **semester-wise feedback system** is implemented, where feedback links are shared with students, and the collected data is analyzed. Prompt feedback is provided to both students and staff, fostering continuous improvement and encouraging cooperation and mutual respect.
- ❖ For the welfare of female students, **sanitary pad vending machines** are installed on the campus.
- ❖ The college also implements a **Book Bank Scheme** to support students by providing essential textbooks, particularly benefiting economically weaker students.



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
