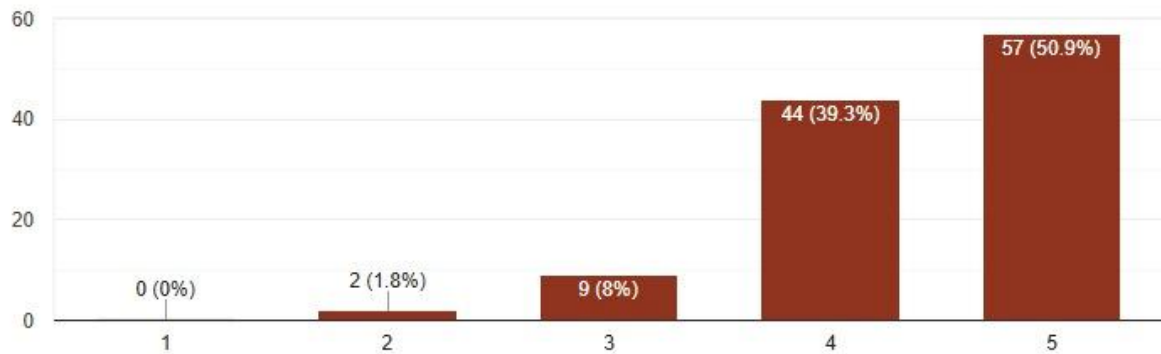
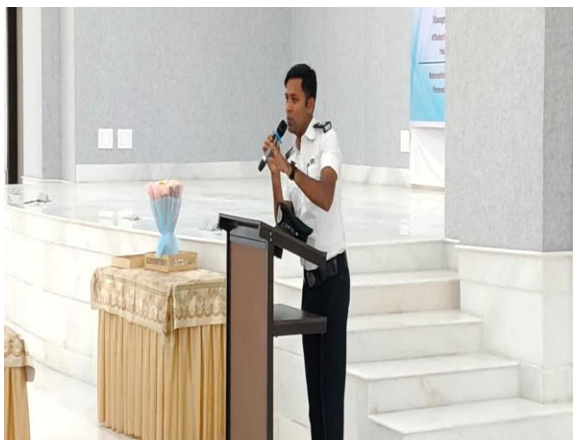


Fig: Overall feedback of the Program
